"Drive Away Hunger"

Over 1160 items were collected from a one-day drive at Food Basics and Pope John Paul Catholic School.

Cash donations of \$330 will help us purchase fresh fruit.

Sherri Munro, (m) Branch Manager Lindsay, TD Canada Trust and Laurie Scott (I) present a cheque for \$3,500 for our fresh fruit program.

Between 12-15 schools receive fresh fruit weekly from our warehouse. By giving students a chance to try fruit that they may not otherwise have, the program may open the door to a lifetime of healthy food choices.
