Drive-Thru Food Drive

On May 13th, we organized a citywide drive-thru food drive at 14 locations across the City of Kawartha Lakes. Across all locations, an estimated 382 families and individuals made donations, and **7,455 pounds** of food were collected.

Porch Food Drive!



Since March, community members in a downtown Lindsay neighborhood have been hosting a weekly pop-up food drive on the front porch of a vacant home owned by a generous family. Each week, donations were welcomed to be dropped off, and at the end of each day, donations were collected by a KLFS volunteer. This helped us immensely during the height of COVID-19, as it relieved a lot of pressure on our distribution centre team, while still bringing in a significant amount of donations. Emergency Food Boxes

Feed Ontario, the provincial association of food banks, produced and ship over **100,000 Emergency Food Boxes** to their member agencies throughout Ontario, including us
