## 20th Anniversary Timeline

The idea for a central depot for local food banks was born in 2000, when a collective of community members representing a variety of local organizations answered the **call to action** when observing a sudden increase in individuals seeking food support.

**KLFS officially opened its doors on March 3, 2002.** At that time, those around the organizing table agreed upon a mission of supporting those who feed our hungry. Now, twenty years later, KLFS is still doing just that, thanks to the strong foundations laid during those early years.

The KLFS 20th Anniversary Committee combed through the archives and put together a **historic timeline** that highlights the many community members and groups who have shaped the non-profit to be the leading local organization it is today.
