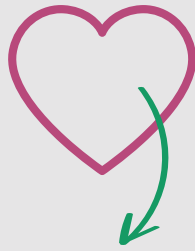

KLFS Featured Food Bank - Omeme

Founded in 1992 by the Omeme Christ Church, the **Omeme Food Bank is a shopping-style food bank serving roughly 55 individuals in the area.** This way, Food Bank Chair Cathie Morrissey says, "we know that the clients can pick what they want, and what they know they can use."



Currently, roughly one-third of the Omeme Food Bank's clients receive a monthly food box which is delivered to their homes by volunteers. Our New Freezer

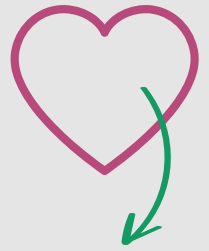
Storage space in the distribution centre has now expanded to accommodate frozen donations with the addition of our brand-new walk-in freezer! **Donations of perishable and frozen items are always welcome at the Kawartha Lakes Food Source.** If you are considering donating perishable items, please ensure that they are brought to the distribution centre rather than being left in donation barrels. When left in donation barrels they too often are squished or are not kept at a safe temperature and therefore cannot be used.
