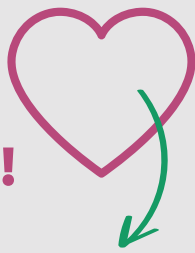
## NEW BARRELS AND COIN BOXES

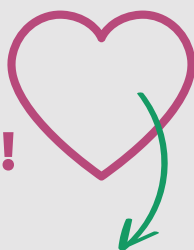
